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Parent Note: You can practice your baby steps, skips and leaps...try mimicking rhythms/paces too! Can you make your bell sound like it is galloping? Keeping a steady beat as you march around the room? Use the capital solfeg (DO is the red bell - key of C) to practice reading steps and skips. Play the  like slugs. Hit the X on the floor. (Your child will love this!!)

We encourage you to help your child to focus on the note relationships, rather than the color of the bell. This will help them see note relationships clearer and help them sight-read earlier and faster. What a rhythmic child you have!
